All applications to the Junior Infants or the Special Class (for ALL class groups) in Carrigtwohill CNS will only be accepted after 02/10/23 and the closing date for receipt of applications is 25/10/23. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All transfer applications to Senior Infants, First Class, Second Class, Third Class, Fourth Class, Fifth Class or Sixth Class in Carrigtwohill CNS other than to the Special Class, will only be accepted after the 02/10/23 and the





closing date for receipt of applications is the 25/10/23. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

Please be reminded that, in line with the school's Admission Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply. Therefore, if a child is seeking a place in the Special Class and is not successful in a given academic year or is on a waiting list for this year, a new application must be made for the following year.
